


A customer walks in to Culver's on sunny afternoon in March



A customer then approaches the counter to order his food from the user




A customer approaches automatic hand sanitizer dispenser




A customer orders his drink and then walks to side counter to get cutlery




A customer uses his foot to activate sensor




A customer uses the pedals to dispense a straw for his drink



A customer receives the hand sanitizer




A customer receives his straw from the dispenser




- Need addressed: essential works not trusting customers to be sanitary while refilling cups




Wearable Receipt Bracelet


possibly made more efficient wa device
